

2017-2018 BCS Scholarships



Application Process:

Once admitted to the university, students should login to their MyState account and complete the General Scholarship Application. At that point, students will be eligible for the university and department scholarships they qualify for with no necessary further action on their part (*auto-match*). Some scholarships have an additional application process (*apply-to*); students should login to their MyState account after completing the General Scholarship Application to see if any of these scholarships are available to them and complete the additional application steps for each.

Application Deadlines:

- **Incoming Freshmen:** December 1 (for the following academic yr.)
- **Current and Entering Transfer Students:** March 1 (for the following academic yr.)

Available Scholarships:

In addition to scholarships offered through the Office of Admissions and Scholarships and other scholarships, there are a variety of scholarships available for BCS students. The number of scholarships awarded and scholarship dollar amounts vary by year.

Full-time females who have completed their second-year in the BCS program.
Minimum GPA of 3.0.
Demonstrated leadership and academic excellence in the program.
- **Brasfield & Gorrie Building Construction Scholarship**
Students in good academic standing with the university.
- **Brislin, Inc. Annual Scholarship**
Minimum of 2.75 GPA.
Of good moral character.
Demonstrated leadership ability.
- **Chip & Jennifer Crane Endowed Scholarship**
Students in good standing.
Minimum GPA of 3.0.
Demonstrated financial need.
- **Kline Mechanical Systems Annual Scholarship**
Incoming freshmen.
Strong high school academic record and leadership experience.
- **Mississippi Contractors Endowed Scholarship**
Minimum GPA of 3.0.
Demonstrated financial need.
- **MS Associated Builders & Contractors Scholarship Fund**
Minimum GPA of 3.0.
Demonstrated financial need.
- **Yates Construction Co. Annual Scholarship**
Member of Black Student Alliance or an African American student.
Minimum GPA of 3.0.
Demonstrated leadership abilities through extracurricular involvement
