

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to the Design Discovery Workshop. We are going to have an enjoyable week that will aid in your understanding of architecture as a profession, and of the demands and expectations of architecture school. During the week you will participate in projects and exercises that open your mind to the world of design. The experience will be a positive one that may ultimately help you choose a major and profession.

Each student camper has been assigned to a group that will be lead by a counselor/instructor. Constant supervision will be provided throughout the week. We are all going to have a fun and safe time. Here are some reminders and information that will aid in the success of camp:

- **Please remember that you (parents, too) are in an academic institution of higher learning**, and thusly, need to be respectful of the protocols for this environment (they may differ from what you are used to).

- **CELL PHONES MUST ALWAYS BE ON "SILENT MODE" IN THIS BUILDING - - - NO EXCEPTIONS (AND NO TEXT MESSAGING IN THIS BUILDING)**. PLEASE GO OUTSIDE TO COMMUNICATE ON YOUR PHONE WHEN NECESSARY.

- Each student/camper has a meal card with \$60.00 on it. You will have to pay for the following number of meals with this card (we will supply the others and snacks):

Breakfast	1
Lunch	5
Dinner	3

-No one wants to run out of money, so a good idea would be to spend no more than \$6.50 on lunch and \$7.50 on dinner + tax (cafeteria prices). The card work at the Perry Cafeteria, Chik-fil-a, Subway, and the MSU Bakery.

- Campers will eat out with their counselors and group one night during the week. Meal cards will not work for this meal; we recommend that you have \$10 - \$20 dollars for this meal.

- Fines will be issued for lost keys and electronic cards:

Dorm Key:	\$70.00
Meal Card:	\$60.00
Security card:	\$ 25.00

- Remember to always walk in groups to and from the dorms or other places on campus. Counselors will escort campers at night in groups (as will campus police upon phone request).

- The number to the **MSU Campus Police department is 662.325.2121** (parents can also call this number in an emergency if they need to contact their child).

- No campers will be allowed to drive during the week. You must give car keys to your instructor/counselor; they will be given to the director to be locked up. This is for your own safety and for camp liability reasons. (Special arrangements to get access to keys for errands, etc. can be arranged; talk to your instructor.) Vehicles must be parked as directed in other literature.

- Alcohol, firearms, explosives, illegal substances, and weapons are not permitted in the dorms, architecture building, or anywhere else on campus. Campers will be sent home immediately if they fail to meet any of these requirements or if other disciplinary issues occur. **Tobacco and tobacco products NOT allowed inside any buildings on campus.**
