The Mississippi State University School of Architecture is offering a limited number of scholarships for high school students living in Leflore County, Mississippi or for a minority (member of a class underrepresented in higher education) high school student to attend the 2009 session of Design Discovery. These scholarships are made possible through the generosity of the architectural firm of Johnson-McAdams Firm, P.A., Greenwood, Mississippi. Each scholarship will pay for all costs (except for one meal) of the selected participant: meals, lodging, and supplies. The scholarship will be awarded to the student who submits the best entry consisting of the following:
