For example, 42% of BCS graduates who completed a survey reported having an internship or co-op. Of those, 55% reported receiving a full-time offer. Of those that received an offer, 83% of them accepted the offer, so 45% of BCS graduates who completed a survey and had an internship or co-op converted to full-time employees with their intern/co-op employer.
