

CAMP TOPICS

Interior Design 101. Students will explore the professional practice of interior design and what careers are available with an interior design degree. Student counselors will share their experiences as design majors and how they spend their time in college.

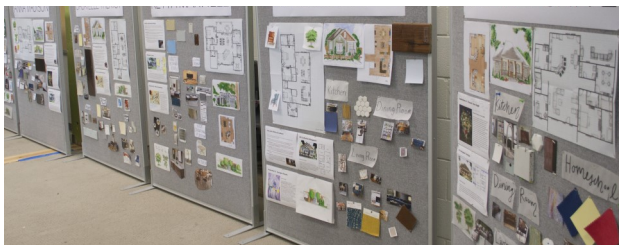
Living Spaces. Students will recognize and apply principles and elements of design to a residential project. Students will select inspiration images, design the space, and render and model their design.

Sketches and Perspectives. Students will apply freehand sketching and perspective drawing to understand the built environment.

Lighting Design. Students will explore the importance of natural and artificial light for physical and psychological health. Students will complete a hands-on lighting activity and use our MSU Lighting Application Center to investigate lighting effects.

Rendering Techniques. Students will learn how to render with markers and pencils using a quick and fun method. Students will take their created sketches and perspectives and add color and texture.

Exhibit Design and Preparation: As students create design artifacts throughout the week, the group will create a student work exhibit to share with family and friends.

COST

The total cost of the camp is \$650.00. This includes a non-refundable application fee of \$100.00 which must be enclosed with the application. Upon notification of acceptance to the **idesign** camp, the remaining \$550.00 fee is due by May 10, 2019. Make all checks payable to the "**MSU Interior Design Program, idesign summer camp**". If for some unforeseen reason, you need to cancel your attendance, you will receive 100% of your \$550 prior to May 15 and 50% prior to May 24. No refund will be available after May 24.

Camp fee Includes Instruction by MSU faculty and counselors, t-shirt, supplies throughout, room + board in MSU residence hall dorm rooms and university fees for health services, equipment, facilities and libraries.
